## National Technical Honor Society



### What is National Technical Honor Society (NTHS)?

NTHS is new to Millbrook High School. The National Technical Honor Society (NTHS) serves over 80,000 student members annually. In 2015, NTHS awarded over \$200,000 in scholarships to career and technical education students. NTHS honors the achievements of top CTE students, provides scholarships to encourage the pursuit of higher education, and cultivates excellence in today's highly competitive and skilled workforce.

### What are the requirements?

- Junior or Senior
- 3.2 (unweighted) GPA & 3.5 GPA in CTE courses
- Completed 2 CTE courses or enrolled in at least a level 2 CTE course for the school year towards completing a pathway
- Active member of a CTSO (DECA, FFA, FCCLA, HOSA, or TSA) strongly encouraged
- Complete 5 community service hours plus 1 hour CTE Teacher help per semester
- No major disciplinary record
- Teacher recommendation

*Teacher recommendation based on the ability to follow instructions, work in a team, show pride in work, be dependable, responsible, and honest, demonstrate a positive attitude, leadership skills, citizenship, and initiative. Students may select the teacher to complete the recommendation to be turned in to Mr. Walker.*

### How much does it cost?

The membership fee is \$30 per student. This is a one-time fee. Students do not need to renew their membership. Students will need to pay the \$30 membership fee via the On-Line School Payment (OSP) link at the bottom of the school's website homepage. ### What do I get?

As a member, you will receive a membership certificate, portfolio, and card to showcase your lifetime membership. In addition, you will receive an official NTHS diploma seal, graduation tassel, lapel pin, and window decal to show your affiliation with NTHS.

Once the student logs in to the NTHS website, he or she may request up to three personal letters of recommendation for employment, college admission, or scholarship committees and gain access to the NTHS Online Career Center including these valuable services: Career Safe and Career Key.

### When is the deadline?

NTHS students that have registered prior to January each year may be eligible to apply for scholarships online beginning in January! For this reason, applications and membership fees must be submitted by October 31, 2016.

### Follow these steps to join National Technical Honor Society.

- 1) Check your unweighted GPA to be sure you at least have a 3.2.
- 2) Ask one of your teachers to write you a recommendation.
- 3) Complete the membership application and turn in to Mr. Walker in Room 2606.
- 4) Pay the \$30 membership fee via the On-Line School Payment (OSP) link at the bottom of the school's website homepage.
- 5) Contact Mr. Walker if you have any questions about anything.
