Release of Student Information to Recruiters (Military and Institutions of Higher Education)

Federal law 107-110 (No Child Left Behind Act of 2001, Section 9528) requires schools to provide recruiters from the military and institutions of higher education, upon request, with the name, address, and telephone number of enrolled students. It is the policy of Millbrook High School to release this requested information ONLY regarding Juniors and Seniors.

This information may be mailed, faxed (919-850-8803), or personally delivered to Student Services or Mr. Walker in Room 249 within the first twenty days of the school year. "Opt Out" information that is received after the first twenty days will be filed and those names will be deleted from the distribution list at the beginning of the next school year.
